Black Walnut <i>Juglans nigra</i> . . . . .	. Nut crop; grows large
Butternut <i>Juglans cinerea</i> . . . . .	. Nut crop; uncommon
Pignut Hickory <i>Carya glabra</i> . . . . .	. Nut crop; grows large
Bitternut (Yellow Bud) Hickory <i>Carya cordiformis</i> . . . . .	. Nut crop; grows large
Shagbark Hickory <i>Carya ovata</i> . . . . .	. Nut crop; grows large
Red Oak <i>Quercus rubra</i> . . . . .	. Acorns; grows large
Scarlet Oak <i>Quercus coccinea</i> . . . . .	. Acorns; grows large
White Oak <i>Quercus alba</i> . . . . .	. Acorns; grows large
Shingle Oak <i>Quercus imbricaria</i> . . . . .	. Acorns; grows large
Black Oak <i>Quercus velutina</i> . . . . .	. Acorns; grows large
Swamp White Oak <i>Quercus bicolor</i> . . . . .	. Acorns; grows large; wet sites
Sugar Maple <i>Acer saccharum</i> . . . . .	. Autumn foliage; grows large
Black Gum <i>Nyssa sylvatica</i> . . . . .	. Attractive foliage and berries
Cucumber Magnolia <i>Magnolia acuminata</i> . . . . .	. Flowers; berries
Tulip Poplar <i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i> . . . . .	. Flowers; rapid growth
Black Cherry <i>Prunus serotina</i> . . . . .	. Cherries
Serviceberry <i>Amelachier arborea or laevis</i> . . . . .	. Flowers; berries
American Beech <i>Fagus grandifolia</i> . . . . .	. Nut crop; smooth bark
Sassafras <i>Sassafras albidum</i> . . . . .	. Foliage, berries
American Sycamore <i>Plantanus occidentalis</i> . . . . .	. Rapid growth; grows large

### SHRUBS/UNDERSTORY TREES

Alternate-leaf Dogwood <i>Cornus alternifolia</i> . . . . .	. Berries
Flowering Dogwood <i>Cornus florida</i> . . . . .	. Flowers; berries
Common Spicebush <i>Lindera benzoin</i> . . . . .	. Berries; foliage; scent
PawPaw <i>Asimina triloba</i> . . . . .	. Foliage; fruit
Nannyberry <i>Viburnum lentago</i> . . . . .	. Berries
Smooth Blackhaw <i>Viburnum prunifolium</i> . . . . .	. Berries
Winterberry <i>Ilex verticillata</i> . . . . .	. Berries
